## Crystalens Expectation Form

Loden Vision Centers has explained to me that the purpose of upgrading to crystalens is to decrease my dependence on glasses. I have been told that my vision will not be perfect 20/20 at both distances, intermediate and near.

---

Loden Vision Centers has explained to me that to achieve my best potential with my near vision, that it will take a minimum of three (3) months and it may require a second procedure with laser or an Intraocular lens to obtain my best uncorrected distance vision.

---

Loden Vision Centers has explained to me that +1.00 and +1.50 readers may be needed to see fine print, read a book, or perform complex near vision tasks.

---

Loden Vision Centers has told me that there is a 30% chance of needing low power bifocals 100% of the time for near vision if my distance vision is 20/25 or better uncorrected.

---

Loden Vision Centers has explained to me that LASIK or PRK may be needed to enhance my uncorrected vision. This will not occur until at least 3-6 months following my initial surgery.

---

This line may not be perfectly clear when read, but over 70% of patients should be able to read this line without spectacles.
